Taylor and Lee are in a relationship. Lee is always trying to change things about Taylor's appearance. Every time Taylor walks into the room, Lee will say things like, "Why are you wearing that? Your hair looks horrible. I'm not going out with you looking like that!" Lee is also leaving that type of comments online when Taylor posts a new photo of them. Taylor feels hurt that Lee is never happy about the way they look.

Taylor communicated their feelings about the situation with Lee, but Lee told Taylor he needs to feel proud and confident, not ashamed, to be in a romantic relationship in public with them.
